Hand Washing

- Hand washing facilities with soap in place.
- Drying of hands with disposable paper towels.
- Staff encouraged to protect their skin.
- Hand Sanitisers

Attendees to be reminded on a regular basis to wash their hands for 20 seconds with water and soap and the importance of proper drying with disposable towels. Also reminded to catch coughs and sneezes in tissues – Follow Catch it Kill it Bin it and to avoid touching face, eyes, nose or mouth with unclean hands. Tissues will be made available throughout the workplace.

Cleaning

 All carpets and soft furnishings have been deep cleaned. After each performance auditoria, stage (front and back) & public areas will be treated with an Ozone generator.

 all touch surfaces treated with special 30 day sanitizing agent Before any public, cast or member attendance extra cleaning will be undertaken to top up 30 day sanitizer

BAR

- Café tables will be two meters apart.
- All staff will wear see through Perspex face coverings
- Contactless payment is encouraged.
- One way system and 2 metre distancing in force

Spare/replacement masks behind bar for staff. Staff given instructions on use of masks

Floor markings showing one ways system in bar area and for toilets

 Hand sanitizer at bar area for public. Staff will use 24 hour sanitizer to lessen risk of damage to skin due to overuse of standard hand sanitizer.

Backstage Area

All casts and crew, contractors staff, registrars must have a thermal check before entering. Failure of thermal check in first instance: person failing asked to sit outside for 5 minutes before taking next step. Check Ok admittance allowed. Failure 2nd test again after 5 mins. OK admittance allowed failure-asked for know medical systems giving high temp. Otherwise admittance denied

All Casts, members and contractors when required should wear face masks. Cast and members in particular when waiting to go on stage should still wear masks

Spare face masks available in back stage area with First Aid Kit.

On stage in public performances and during rehearsals The following should be observed 2mt social distancing where ever possible with a minimum 1mt if this is not possible. Cast etc should avoid direct face to face talking, singing wherever possible

Audience should be seated at least 2.4mts from front of stage to avoid droplet spread

Staff and members made aware of symptoms of COVID 19 via posters and email advice If a member of staff or attendee shows symptoms of Covid 19 they will be immediately sent home and all the contacts traced. Any areas of the building they have been working will be shut down and deep cleaned.
